



Fire safety

1. FIRE SAFETY EQUIPMENT

It is vital to the safety of the Hall that the fire alarm and fire-fighting equipment are kept in full working order. Interfering with fire safety equipment is a serious disciplinary offence.

Anyone caught tampering with fire extinguishers, smoke detectors, or fire alarm call points will be reported immediately to the Warden and required to leave the Hall within 48 hours.

2. REDUCING RISK OF FIRE

A. You may not keep or use any of the following in your study bedroom:

- **candles** (including tea lights and scented candles);
- **fragrance burners** (e.g. incense sticks, oil burners);
- **shisha pipes, hookahs, bongos, etc** (no smoking is allowed in Hall);
- **cooking equipment** (e.g. toasters, microwaves, fryers, rice cookers);
- **heaters** (e.g. gas or electric heaters, oil-filled radiators);
- **clothes irons.**

Spot checks will be performed; any such items found will be confiscated.

B. Do not obstruct corridors or stairways with luggage, rubbish, or furniture.

C. Do not stick posters or notes to either side of your door; for these can allow fire to spread beyond the fire-resistant door much more quickly.

D. Report any matters of concern to a member of staff immediately.
